- a. Consideration discussion and possible Action: Megan Young would like to discuss raising the trash service rates for the businesses only. Megan built a report on what republic charges the city. The issue is that they raised the price on all services in 2024 above the 5% rate. None of the businesses within the city were ever raised. In our system we didn't go up in a rates but some went down, but the city is paying most of the business rates. The first report Megan printed showed a total of 549 accounts being charged. We only have a total of 295 garbage cans/dumpsters. Residentials are good and don't need to be raised, the businesses will have to have there prices raised so the city is not losing money.

Malisia Doyle made a motion to match the rate increase and then at a later date we re-evaluate and raise again in August when Republic raises 5% again.
